

## Proposal for Memorial Plaque Area in Murton Cemetery

There are a few plaques on the existing cemetery walls. The walls need regular maintenance.

In the last year three requests have been received for a space to put a memorial to one or more people who have been cremated and whose ashes are not interred in the cemetery. A plaque commemorating those lost because of the Coronavirus pandemic could also be included as there have been local deaths both directly and indirectly due to the disease.

There is space at the south east corner of the cemetery where a memorial area could be created.

The Clerk and Cllr Govan have discussed the idea and are making the proposal for a stone seating area where plaques could be placed. The photos below are of garden seating areas based on sheepfolds and are examples of the type of space proposed<sup>1</sup>.

Size, design, costing and funding would have to be researched.
