# VACANCY - PARISH COUNCILLOR

**Would you like to become more involved in your local community?**

**Represent your community in making decisions which affect local services?**

**And generally ensure that the quality of life for residents in the parish of Murton is a priority in local affairs?**

**Then why not volunteer to become a parish councillor?**

Murton Parish includes Murton, Hilton, Brackenber, Coupland Beck, Flakebridge and Langton Beck.

Murton Parish Council meets 4-5 times each year at 7.30 on Monday evenings in Murton Institute. The next meeting is 7 February 2022.

Induction and training is available and is provided by Cumbria Association of Local Councils. Expenses are covered for attending training.

**To be a parish councillor you must be:**

- 18 years or over
- a British subject or a citizen of a member state of the European Union
- an elector of the parish; or (b) a person who over the whole of the last twelve months has been owner or tenant of land or premises in the parish or has lived in the parish or within three miles or has had his principal place of work in the parish.

Apply in writing to the Parish Clerk (address above) **by Wednesday 5 January 2022**. You should provide an outline of your skills, relevant experience and reasons for wanting to become a parish councillor.

Applications will be reviewed, and a decision made regarding the person to be co-opted onto the Parish Council made at the meeting on 7 February 2022.
